Peru Facts

- Borders with Chile, Argentina, Brazil, Ecuador, and Bolivia.
- Total area of 1,285,220 km², about four times the size of Italy.
- Its highest point is Mount Huascarán, at 6,768 meters above sea level.
- A population of about 30.77 million in 2014.
- A GDP of 202.9 billion USD in 2014.

A Special Destination

The Peruvian territory comprises three natural regions (coast, highlands, and jungle), each characterized by distinct climates:

- The Coast (Ica, Chiclayo, Lima, Trujillo, and Tumbes) or Northern Region: warm climate year-round, with summer peaks reaching around 35°C.
- The Highlands (Ancash, Arequipa, Ayacucho, Cajamarca, Cusco, and Puno): these regions have two seasons: winter from April to October and summer from November to March. Winter is dry, while summer brings rain.

The Jungle or tropical forest (Iquitos, Puerto Maldonado, and Manu):

- High Jungle (forest at around 700 meters altitude) has a subtropical climate with heavy rainfall.
- Low Jungle (below 700 meters altitude) has two seasons: the dry, sunny winter (April to October) and the rainy summer (November to March), with much more frequent rainfall.
